The verse for week 41 October 4-10

Note: We took a look at this verse in August when we focused on the word Faith and it is worth repeating over as we dig deeper into trust.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths" Proverbs 3:5-6

God wants us to put Him first in our lives. He wants us to put our confidence and trust in Him, all the time, in everything. Trusting God is believing that:

- He has the power to help you
- He wants to help you
- He will help you.
