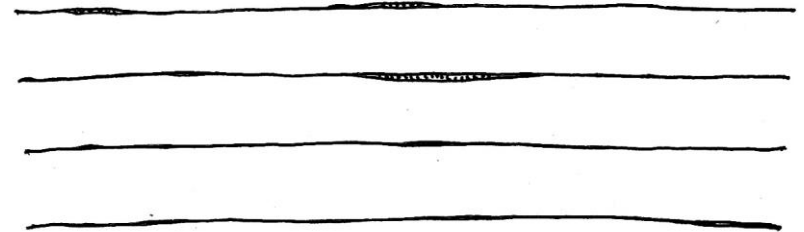
Verse:
