

Last Minute Holiday Cookie Idea

Sorta Homemade gingerbread cookies



Supply list

Gingerbread cookies from Trader Joes (2.99)
 1 cup powder sugar
 2-3 Tablespoons of water
 Holiday Sprinkles
 Clean Hands

It's almost Christmas, you still have shopping to do, gifts to wrap, cards to address, laundry, dinners, lunches, homework, teachers gifts to send, cookies to bake...Too much to do & not enough time?

Take a look at a very simple and inexpensive way to get your "Holiday Baking" done in no time...and...the kids can do this with you!



Step One ~ wash hands and sort out all broken gingerbread cookies. Eat the broken pieces and/or share those with your family. Set out complete cookies (remember Gingerbread girls, first!)



Step Two ~ Mix 1 cup powdered sugar with approx. 2 tablespoons of water. Mix until glaze is smooth. Add additional water to thin out if necessary.



Step Three ~ Lightly drop cookie, one at a time, into glaze to coat front side. Gently lift and lightly shake off excess glaze.



Step Four ~ Place glaze side up to "set". Repeat three above steps until you have 3-4 cookies setting.



Step Five ~ Lightly apply colored sugar/sprinkles to each cookie and let set to dry.
